Rising Stars is off to a great start!! Your children are working very hard and are excited about their upcoming performance. Here are some dates you need to remember:

WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 2ND: Wednesday is **LATE STAY DAY!** This is our one late stay rehearsal.

- Everyone's participation is essential to our production and attendance is mandatory. We greatly appreciate you adjusting your schedule to accommodate this rehearsal. At camp dismissal time, your child will go straight to the Lewis Theater after fifth period. They will be given a break and a light snack. Feel free to send snacks if you have any dietary concerns.
- The rehearsal will end at **6:00 PM**, at which point your child will be escorted to the Lewis Theater Lobby. Camper pick up is on the Holton front circle. Please be prompt.
- Rehearsals are closed to spectators; please wait for your child in the parking circle or the Lewis Theater lobby.


THURSDAY, AUGUST 3RD: Thursday is **SHOW DAY!** Our class will perform "**AN UNEXPECTED GUEST**" on Thursday, August 3rd at 5:15 P.M. in Holton's Lewis Theater. Admission is free and tickets will not be used. Seating will be on a first come, first served basis. Doors will open at **5:00 PM**.

- During the day on Thursday, Rising Stars campers will perform songs from the show at Lunchtime Entertainment. *Please wear your camper T-shirt to camp on Thursday.*
- In addition, Rising Stars campers will meet at **4:00 PM** in the Chorus Room for the pre-performance meeting.
- Extended Day **After Care** is available on the day of the performance; sign up through your [online account](#) and use **discount code RisingStars** to have the fee waived. Rising Stars campers in After Care will be escorted to the Chorus Room for their pre-performance meeting at 4:00.

FRIDAY AUGUST 4TH: Friday is our **CAST PARTY!** During Friday's class time (after the show) we will be holding a "Breakfast Cast Party.". Please send something to share with the class (chips, cookies, fruit, doughnut holes, drinks, cups, etc.). Please be sure treats are commercially prepared with a verified ingredients list so that campers with allergies can be aware. Our class has 40 people.

RISING STARS - Session 2 COSTUMES, HAIR, AND MAKE-UP

Dear Parents of Campers in **Rising Stars**,

Thank you for helping us put together your camper's costume for our upcoming show- we look forward to seeing what they bring in!

COSTUMES

We will provide each camper a list of items they need to bring from home for their costume. Please let us know as soon as possible if any of the items on your camper's list are not available to you so that we can find alternatives.

HAIR

We are happy to help your camper style their hair for the show. For hygienic reasons, each camper should bring in their own hair brush and/or comb and personal hair accessories in a bag labeled with their name.


MAKE-UP

In addition to wearing costumes to help your camper get into character, they also have the option to wear stage make-up appropriate to their character in the show. We ask your permission to apply makeup to your camper, and we can either use make-up that you provide, or stage make-up provided by the camp, using separate applicators for each camper.

We will not apply makeup to your camper without your expressed written permission, and if you prefer that your camper not wear makeup for the show, that is completely acceptable.
