



To ensure camper safety, Creative Summer recommends that campers report to Car Line, to a bus, or to Extended Day at camp dismissal. Campers walking home from camp is not encouraged because Holton-Arms School does not have an exit to a neighborhood with sidewalks; our single point of egress is River Road. However, we understand that some families want to or need to allow their campers to walk home after camp.

To give permission to your camper to walk home from camp, please fill out the form below and return it to the Creative Summer office. Your camper will not be permitted to walk home from Creative Summer until this form has been received by the Creative Summer office.

- Campers age 10 and older may walk home unaccompanied.
- Campers age 7 to 9 may walk home if accompanied by an older sibling age 10 or older.
- Campers younger than age 7 may not walk home from camp unless accompanied by a parent or responsible adult.

My child has my permission to WALK HOME from Creative Summer when camp dismisses at the regular time of 3:00 p.m. This will be my camper's regular dismissal option; this permission will remain in effect unless I notify Creative Summer in writing that I wish to rescind this permission.

I understand that my camper will report to the Holton-Arms front desk at dismissal and check in with a counselor who will escort them to the crosswalk at River Road.

I understand that campers walking home are prohibited from leaving campus via any route other than the crosswalk at River Road, even if accompanied by a responsible adult.

I am aware that once my child leaves the campus, there is no adult supervision for them.

I will inform my child of the following safety guidelines:

- They may not loiter on campus once they have been escorted to River Road, and should go directly to their after-camp destination.
- They should walk on sidewalks or walking paths, and should cross streets at corners or designated crosswalks.
- They should obey all traffic signs and signals.
- They are encouraged to check in with an adult when they arrive at their destination.
